| | | Map No.: B 324 Located across from the Association Docks, Ellen Pearce Island is named after the wife of the original owner, John Pearce. He paid the Crown \$6 for the island's 4.39 acres. In 1910, Ellen's Isle was acquired by Mabel Walton, a spinster from Hamilton, Ontario. Around 1915, a relative, Watson G. Walton, camped on the island and decided to build a cottage. Mr. Walton finished the interior of the cottage beautifully with imported British Columbia cedar. He also had an ice house and a two-storey boathouse built at the back of the cottage on Sunset Bay using lumber |
