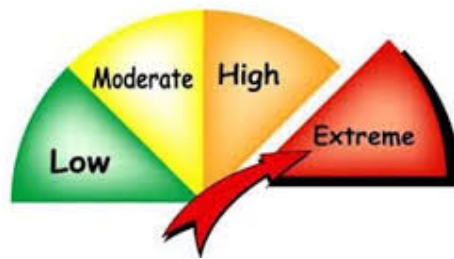
West Parry Sound Area Municipalities
